DECISION n° 159

of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways adopting the technical and functional specifications for the establishment of the One-Stop Shop (OSS)

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR RAILWAYS,

Having regard to the Regulation (EU) 2016/796 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 on the European Union Agency for Railways¹ (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”) and repealing Regulation (EC) No. 881/2004 (hereinafter called “Agency the Regulation”), and in particular Article 12 § 2 and recital 15 thereof,

Whereas:

The proposal of the technical and functional specifications for the establishment of the One-Stop Shop is sufficiently flexible as to allow their further development through the deployment of the planned change management process and in close cooperation and appropriate consultation with the network of national safety authorities referred to in Article 38 of the Agency Regulation;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The technical and functional specifications and a plan for the establishment of the One-Stop Shop (OSS) are adopted as set out in the Vision Document annexed to this decision.

Article 2

The present decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption. It will be published on the Agency website.
