

## 2. Communication events of the year




## The Agency will organize

- (in coopeation with the European Commission) a series of preparatory conferences on the 4<sup>th</sup> Railway Package Technical Pillar in 5 European regions ahead of the RISC meeting in July 2017 (SERA Regional Conferences and SERA Convention)
- a Safety conference in relation to the 4<sup>th</sup> package in Dubrovnik in September 2017 (planned)
- an ERTMS conference in November 2017 in Valenciennes/Anzin
- its participation to the SIFER fair in Lille in March 2017

It will provide key speakers to the above displayed external events and will co-host, as every year since 2015, the ETCR Seminar in Bruge in cooperation with the College of Europe.
