## DECISION n°174

*of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Railways adopting guidelines and the list of the main elements to be included in the cooperation agreements to be concluded between the Agency and the national safety authorities*

### **THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR RAILWAYS,**

Having regard to the Regulation (EU) 2016/796 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 on the European Union Agency for Railways<sup>1</sup> (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”) and repealing Regulation (EC) No. 881/2004 (hereinafter called “the Regulation”), and in particular Article 51 § 1 (t) thereof,

Whereas

The National Safety Authorities have been regularly consulted by means of reports from the chair of the NSA subgroup on the development of the CA during the NSA network;

### **HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:**

#### ***Article 1***

The guidelines and the list of the main elements to be included in the cooperation agreements to be concluded between the Agency and the national safety authorities, taking into account the provisions of Article 76 the Regulation, as set out in the document annexed to this decision.

#### ***Article 2***

The present decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption. It will be published on the Agency website.
