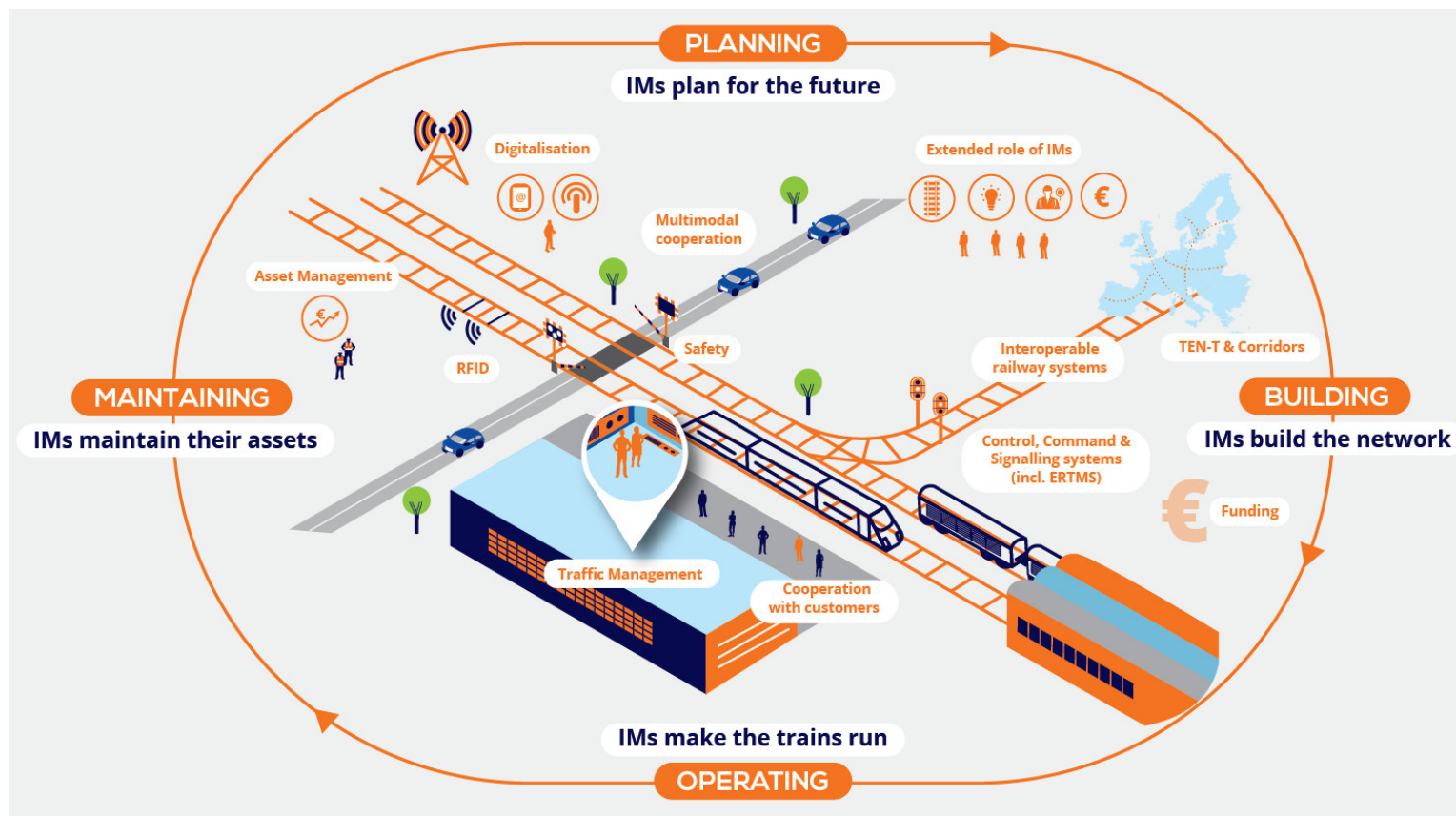
Mission

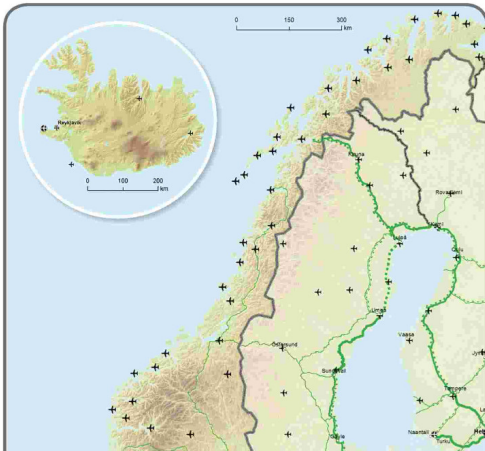

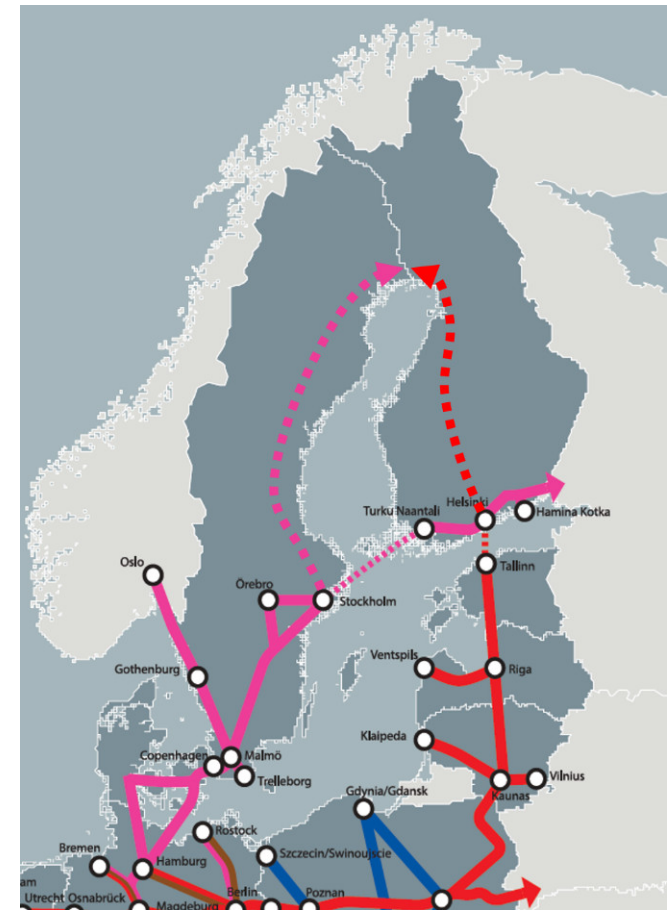
