Areas for Improving the Technical Proposals (1)

Transposition (coherence across Member States)

- EC initiative with RISC
- If notification for transposition after 16th of June 2019
 - NSA will issue part B or additional authorisation Implementing Act on Practical Arrangements

Transition (smooth transition between the two regimes)

 Transfer of file (ERA to assess the remaining requirements)

Series/subsequent authorisation (efficiency of the authorisation and the registration processes)

- Automatic link via the OSS to the registration body, or
- ERA as registration body




Areas for Improving the Technical Proposals (2)

Requirements freeze / Pre- engagement (to secure applicant planning and design)	 Right tools in the legal framework – clarification in guide
Type authorisation holder (balance between efficiency and responsibility)	 Entity managing a change not the type holder New authorisation – proportionate assessment
Updated type authorisation (clarification/ensure harmonised implementation)	 Update to a type authorisation file
Language (efficient process and reduced costs)	 Inputs of the workshops in ERA guide Continue the work with the ERA Management Board




Next steps
