## Training on Safety Culture Oversight

### **OBJECTIVES**

The main objectives of the course are to get acquainted with the European Railway Safety Culture Model and understand how it can be used for activities conducted by National Safety Authorities.

The training course emphasises the need to integrate safety culture in the supervision of railway undertakings and infrastructure managers to have a better understanding of their maturity in the management of safety. The relationship between safety culture and the safety management system is highlighted.

After the course, each participant should have a clear idea on how they can positively influence the national railway safety culture.

### **METHODS**

The 2-day training session has a modular structure.

The cornerstone is the European Railway Safety Culture Model and how to use it.

The following training tools are used during the course:

- *Presentations with supporting materials, illustrated with real-life cases;*
- *Interactive dialogue between the participants and group work sessions guided by the facilitators;*
- *Practical role-play to foster the adoption of the concepts.*
